EFFECTIVE: January 5, 2024

Informational Letter (IL) 2092¹, issued February 1, 2020, gave an update regarding Medication Assisted Treatment (MAT) in response to House File (H.F.) 623.

The Prospective Drug Utilization Review (proDUR) Age Edit on buprenorphine and buprenorphine/naloxone oral medications has been updated. See below for the proDUR Edits in place for these medications.

Prospective Drug Utilization Review (proDUR) Edits: Utilization edits, consistent with lowa Medicaid rules and other state and federal laws, will be enforced.

a. **ProDUR Quantity Limits:** The following quantity limit edits will be implemented. A comprehensive list of all quantity limit edits appears on the <u>Quantity Limit Chart</u>².

| Drug Product | Quantity | Days' Supply |
|------------------------------------|----------|--------------|
| Buprenorphine 2mg | 90 | 30 |
| Buprenorphine 8mg | 90 | 30 |
| Buprenorphine/Naloxone 2- 0.5mg | 90 | 30 |
| Buprenorphine/Naloxone 8- 2mg | 90 | 30 |

b. **ProDUR Age Edit:** Buprenorphine and buprenorphine/naloxone will be payable for members 16 years of age and older.
